



Substitute Bus Driver

Brief Job Description: The job of "School Bus Driver" is done for the purpose of transporting students over scheduled routes and/or special trips; enforcing rules, regulations, and laws to maintain safety during transport; ensuring the vehicle is in safe operating condition; and ensuring safety of students during transport, loading and unloading from buses so that students may enjoy the fullest possible advantage from the district's curricular program.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. High School diploma
2. Valid Driver's License with appropriate endorsement and evidence of insurability.
3. Possess a valid Washington State School Bus Driver's certificate.
4. Demonstrated aptitude or competence for assigned responsibilities.
5. Ability to pass a physical examination, requirements of such provided by the state of Washington.
6. Good driving record
7. Criminal justice fingerprint clearance and drug testing clearance.
8. Evidence of successful performance.

Period of Work: As needed to fill in for absent employees.
